# Spring Wildlife Photography – Triple D Game Farm – Kalispell, MT June 5 - 7, 2010

(June 8th – Inclement Weather/Optional Day)

June is a perfect time to capture great images of new-born animals that few photographers have experienced.

As you probably know, animals can be a difficult subject, so here is a chance to get acquainted with photographing wildlife in a controlled, but entirely natural setting. How about seeing the animal in a beautiful Rocky Mountain location with magnificent light? How about having the animal move around right in front of you with plenty of time to get 100's of shots? This is the Triple D Game



Farm, the best place in North America to photograph native mammals in natural settings. You can expect to go home with many "keepers" that range from close-ups to wide-angle habitat images. The Triple D staff is truly amazing! You won't find a friendlier, more knowledgeable group of people, who have years of experience working with the animals. While your safety is of prime concern to the trainers, you will be closer to large cats, wolves, bear, etc. than you ever thought imaginable. All offsite wilderness compounds are fenced to help control the animals, but they are permitted to roam free and you will be right there with them inside the fence.

### **Highlights**


We will spend 3 days photographing a variety of animals (minimum of 8 sessions) wilderness unique settings compounds specifically designed for photography sessions. Each mornina beginning on June 5th, we will travel short distances from the Game Farm to naturally designed settings to photograph the animals in their natural surroundings. After the morning shooting sessions, you will be free to explore the area, including nearby Glacier National Park, for more photography on your own, or you may opt to hang around at the Game Farm. During these mid-day breaks, we will conduct photo critiques, share information such as digital image editing and workflow, and discuss other useful photo tips that will help improve your portfolio. We will then reconvene, late afternoon or early evening, for an additional photo shooting session. A 4th day (June 8th) will be set aside in case of inclement weather or as an extra day for added optional sessions.



Triple D will guarantee at least 8 species of wildlife to be photographed. Wildlife models may include: grey and black wolves, bobcats, mountain lions, snow leopards, Canadian and Siberian Lynx, various species of fox, Siberian Tiger, grizzly and black bears and more.

#### The Leader

Rick Sheremeta is president of AlpenGlow Productions, Inc.. An avid outdoor and wildlife photographer, his work has been published widely - from calendars to international marketing campaigns,



magazines, and newspapers. Rick is a contract photographer for the Associated Press and he has authored

numerous articles for *Outdoor*Photographer, Shutterbug, Tamron's

Viewfinder and Pro-Learning Center. He is
a photography instructor with the Glacier
Institute and a workshop leader for Outdoor
Adventure River Specialists (OARS). He

learning - so be prepared to enjoy yourself

#### Itinerary

- June 5th 7th: Morning and afternoon photography sessions with the wildlife models at various shooting locations; mid-day break will allow for instruction and free time.
- June 7th 6:00 8:00 PM: Wrap-up session, and workshop comes to an end.
- June 8th: Weather Day or it can be used for additionally purchased photography sessions.

#### What Is Included?

The fee includes 3 days of photography with a minimum of 8 sessions, and photo instruction. We also have a "weather" day built in to our schedule. For an additional fee we can conduct extra photography sessions on the 4th day if desired. Please contact me for details.

### What to Bring?

Lots of energy, extra batteries and a lot of memory cards! It can still be chilly in early June – so bring a jacket and sweater or fleece, a pair of light gloves and hat. Make sure you also have rain gear. A tripod can be used and is always recommended. You will not need long glass - a 70-200mm is more than enough for the majority of the photography. There are some places where a 400-500mm can be used or you can add a teleconverter. If you have a wide angle you mat have some unusual opportunities to use it as well. Bring your flash to catch specular highlights and open up shadow areas.
